



Integration Engineer

General Summary:

The Integration Engineer is responsible for implementing all aspects of radiology workflow software and imaging technology from kick-off to go live. Work directly with customers, vendors, and internal team to identify workflow requirements and ensuring the hardware, software, and network function together. Implementation solutions at customer facilities and work with the infrastructure group to transition sites from integration to operations.

Principal duties and Responsibilities:

- This technical position requires excellent communication and problem-solving skills, proven development experience in complex environments, and the ability to consistently deliver projects on time and within budget.
- Work on multiple projects concurrently, monitor the status of tasks and escalate issues when appropriate.
- Understand the fine points of all applications involved and the impact they have on user workflow.
- Understand system functions and interactions between systems
- Understand the flow of events as driven by users and system functions
- Network configuration (firewall, routers, switches, etc.)
- TCP/IP protocol knowledge
- DICOM and image routing knowledge
- HL7/interface troubleshooting
- Must be able to work with all levels of an organization from CEOs to physicians to support staff.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
- Some travel will be required
